2024 Highlights



PATIENT CARE

Over the course of 2024, East Georgia Regional Medical Center played a vital role, helping people get well and live healthier at more than 300,000 patient encounters across its hospital and growing network of East Georgia Medical and Surgical Associates physician clinics, the pain management clinic, Wound Care Center, the Sleep Center and Statesboro Imaging Center.

UNCOMPENSATED CARE

We provided more than \$100 million in charity and uncompensated care for the community's most vulnerable and have resources to help them secure medications and medical support devices.

QUALITY ER SERVICES

Our emergency department delivered medically necessary, life-saving care at more than 51,000 visits in 2024, regardless of the individual's ability to pay.

ADDRESSING SOCIAL DETERMINANTS OF HEALTH

Through financial donations and acts of service, we support the local charitable and community organizations including Safe Haven/Citizens Against Violence, Hearts and Hands Clinic, Habitat for Humanity and our second annual Jars of Love drive collected more than 1,700 jars of peanut and other nut butters for Christian Social Ministries Food Bank.

DEVELOPING FUTURE PROVIDERS

EGRMC serves as the teaching hospital for Georgia Southern University and Ogeechee Technical College. Through these relationships we continue to train over 400 healthcare students per semester for an even stronger healthcare workforce in the future. EGRMC also serves as a clinical site for medical school students, physician assistants and nurse practitioners to grow healthcare leaders in southeast Georgia.

GROWING CARDIOLOGY SERVICES

More than 3,000 hearts are beating stronger following cardiac procedures performed last year. Eight cardiologists offer life-saving procedures and other treatments, including interventions to open blocked arteries, devices inserted to help the heart rest after a heart attack, pacemakers, internal defibrillators, diagnostic peripheral angiograms and peripheral interventions to diagnose and treat blockages in the extremities and specialized therapy to treat blood clots in the lungs and legs.

GROWING SURGICAL SERVICES

We are strengthening our surgery services with the soon to open expansion of two new operating rooms, and recruitment of interventional pulmonology, interventional cardiac, interventional urology and gastroenterology providers who are performing advanced procedures using new technologies such as robotic-assisted navigational bronchoscopy which helps patients with early diagnosis of lung cancer leading to earlier treatment and improved five year survival rates.

WOMEN'S SERVICES

Welcoming a new baby is a special moment, and our caregiving team supports mothers through prenatal education, delivery, and postpartum recovery. More than 1,500 babies were born in 2024, bringing joy to families across the community. With eight OB/GYNs providing care and delivering at the East Georgia Women's Pavilion, specialized maternity services remain easily accessible.
