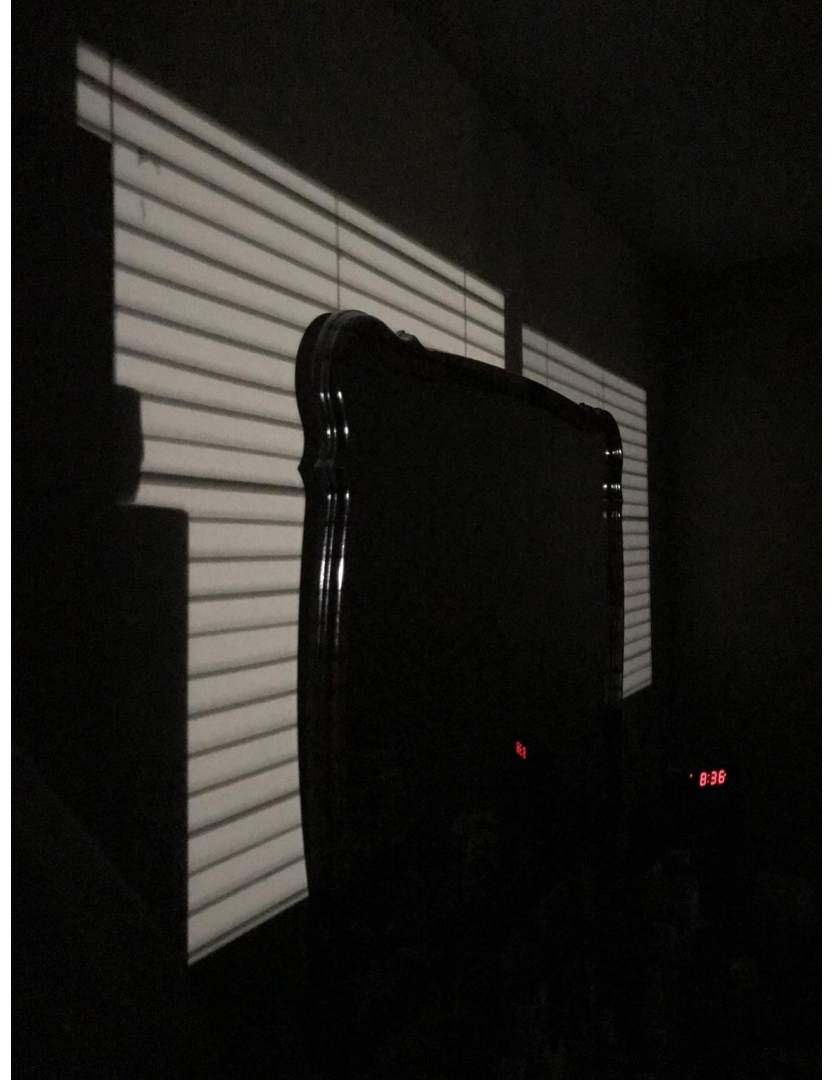

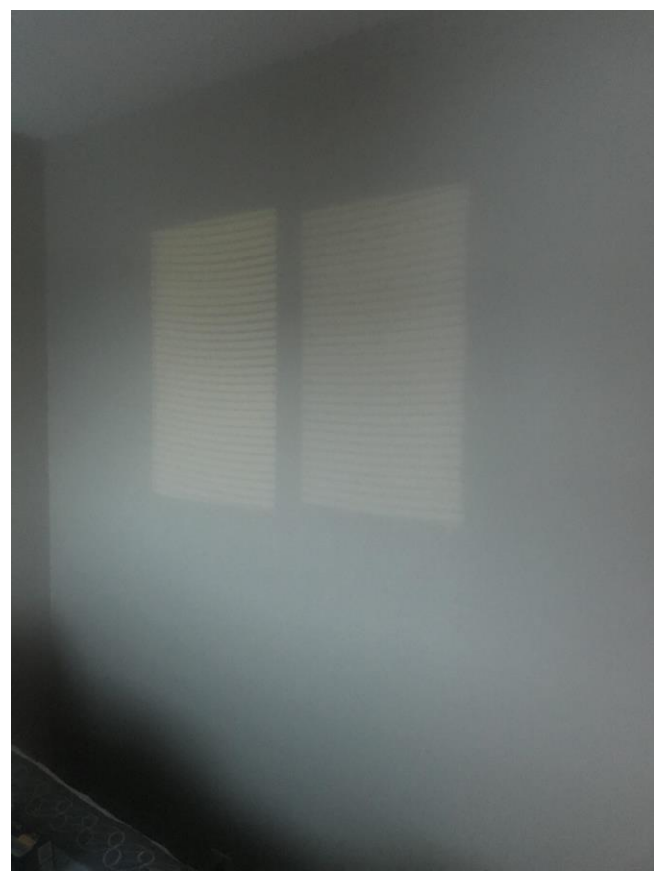

The shadow on the wall is brighter than the light that illuminates the room.



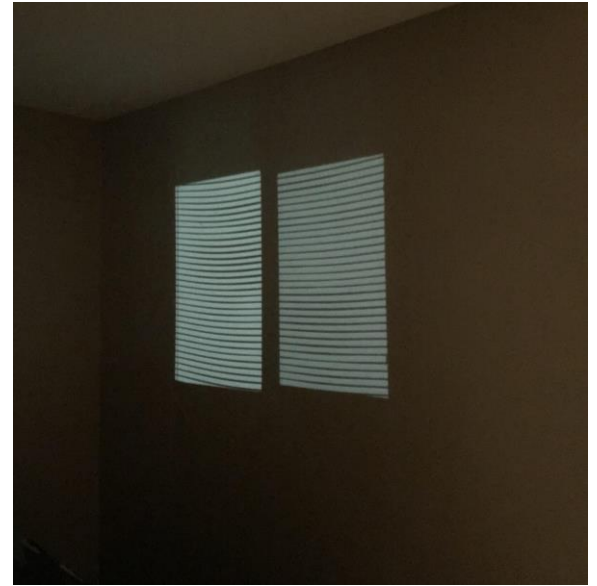
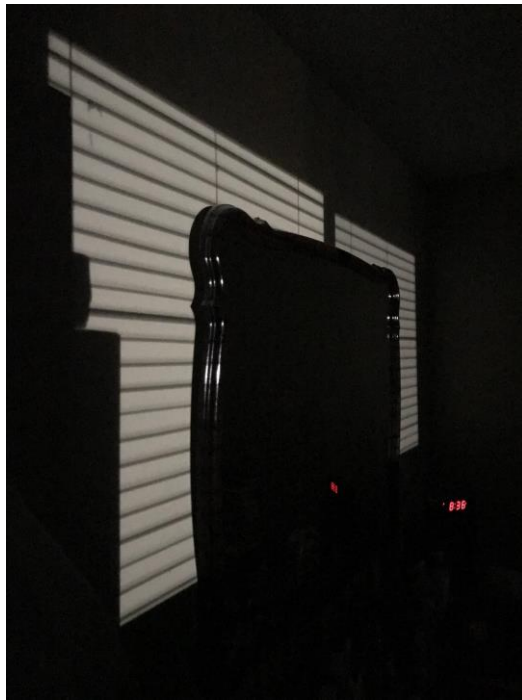
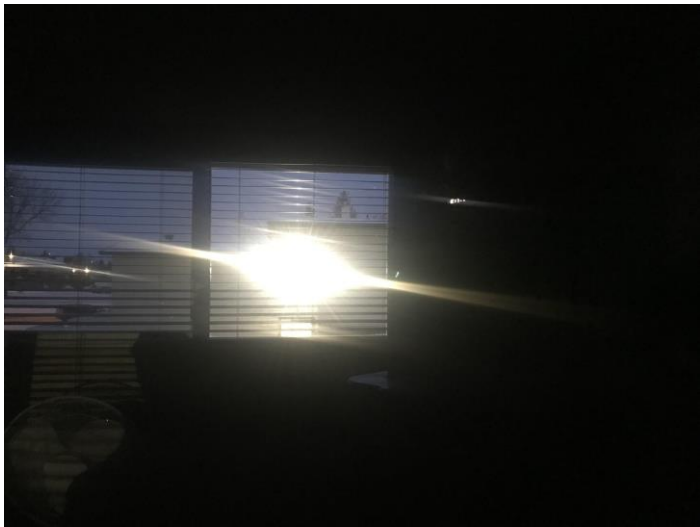

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE AND NUISANCE BYLAW - City of Moose Jaw

Light - 12. No owner of a property shall cause or allow any light fixture attached to that property or illuminated signage to shine directly into the living or sleeping areas of an adjacent dwelling house or to cause a nuisance to an adjacent property.
